

NOTICE TO PRIVATE SCHOOL PARENTS

According to Arizona Revised Statute 15-802, a parent of a child between the ages of six and sixteen must choose public, private, charter, or home school for his or her child's education. Every child must receive instruction in at least the subjects of reading, grammar, mathematics, social studies, and science.

Since you have chosen the private school option, you are required by statute to file an affidavit of intent with the county school superintendent stating that your child is attending a regularly organized private school. This affidavit for private school must be registered with the county school superintendent within thirty days from the time your child begins school.

IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO FILE AN AFFIDAVIT ANNUALLY.

Your private school affidavit remains on file during the entire period of your child's enrollment in private school.

You are required to notify the superintendent's office within thirty days when your child is no longer instructed in this private school.

THE AFFIDAVIT MUST BE SIGNED BY A NOTARY PUBLIC.
